## Phonics

b

**Tricky sound!**

There are 2 ways that Spanish people pronounce this letter.

1. A hard 'b' like in the English word 'bee'. To pronounce this one, the lips come together. Usually, the 'b' is at the start of the word.

Examples:

El boxeo – boxing

Buenos días – Good morning

2. A softer 'b' where the lips don't quite touch.

Examples:

El bebé – baby (has both!)

La habitación - room

ci

Although this is not a new sound, we will use it. The 'ci' grapheme make a 'thee' sound, so la natación sounds like *na-ta-thee-on*.

(Él/ella) Practica – He/she does

(Nosotros) Practicamos – We do

(Vosotros) Practicáis – You (all) do

(Ellos/ellas) Practican – They do

### Noun

Consolidate understanding of gender and nouns. There are some patterns that help to identify the nouns gender.

**Masculine nouns:**

Often end in -o, like el boxeo.

**Femine nouns:**

Often end in -a, like la esgrima.

Can also end in -ción, like la natación.
