Simple greetings:

¡Hola! ¿Cómo te llamas?
Hello! What's your name?

¡Buenos días! Me llamo Sofía
Good morning! My name is Sofia.

Buenas tardes, ¿Cómo estás?
Good afternoon, how are you?

Estoy bien
I am good

Estoy regular I am okay

Estoy mal
I am sad/bad

Buenas noches ¡Adiós!
Goodnight, goodbye!

0 – cero	
1 – uno	6 – seis
2 – dos	7 – siete
3 – tres	8 – ocho
4 – cuatro	9 – nueve
5 – cinco	10 – diez

Phonics

ll

'll' makes a 'y' sound so *me llamo* sounds like 'me yamo'.

Examples:

Me llamo – my name is
Amarillo - yellow

ce

'ce' makes a 'hay' sound so *cero* sounds like 'thayro'

Examples:

cero – zero
once - eleven

Grammar

Verbs

Verbs are doing or being words and help us to make complete sentences.

We will learn some examples of verbs in the first person, so verbs talking about 'I', e.g. I am called.

Me llamo – I am called/my name is

Estoy – I am (for feelings)
