Phonics

g

Makes a hard 'g' and sounds similar to 'goo'.

Examples:

Me gusta – I like

El guante – the glove

Guatemala

q

In Spanish, 'qu' makes a hard 'k', without the 'w' like in English.

Examples:

quince (*keenthay*) -15

¿qué? (*kay*) – what?

Accents

Accents show the vowel is stressed, like in the word **fú-t-bol**.

Grammar

Better understand the rules of adjectival agreement:

Mi hermano es bajo
My brother is short

Mi hermana es baja
My sister is short

Mis hermanos son bajos
My brothers are short

Mis hermanas son bajas
My sisters are short

Verbs

Explore full verb conjugation:

Soy – I am Somos – We are
Eres – You are Sois – You are (plural)
Es – He/she/it is Son – They are

Me llamo – I am called
Se llama – He/she/it is called
